Her characteristic symbol is a butterfly, this time used with a special technique of 3D applique. The collection is characterized by originally constructing minimalistic silhouettes, combining them with natural leather and fur.

Kätlin Kaljuvee (Estonia). The Horsewhisperers

She has always admired the life's diversity and beauty of life, side by side with tragical, magical powers of nature. The new collection is inspired by gypsies who can speak the language of wild horses. Handmade Drawings and prints are transferred into silk.

In every collection is the idea about longevity of items and the reduction of waste. Ingrida uses used men's shirts and jackets, devoid of unstitching or cutting up. The almost forgotten elegant sensation of grace and aristocracy is revived.

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
